#### Short Description


In order to construct a Problem-Solving CANVAS the following steps are in order:

1. you define the problem (the problem changing point of view can be seen as a growth opportunity)
2. we try to understand why the problem occurs
3. what are the requirements for a good solution
4. list of solutions
5. list of resources needed for current solution
6. test and validation
7. measurement

The problem Solving Canvas is a tool that allows you to optimize the solution process of a problem or to reach a goal in the shortest time possible and with minimum effort and therefore of be faster and know how to respond to problems in a timely manner
